



TO NAVIGATE AROUND THE MAP

To move or pan around the map, click, and hold down the left mouse button and move your cursor. (These instructions are for when using the map on a PC. The map may function differently on a smartphone or tablet.)



OPENING A LEGEND

In the upper right-hand corner of the map click the left icon with the three lines. This will open a simple legend.



FINDING A TRAIL AND HOW TO GET THERE

Want to use public transportation to walk or bike a trail, greenway, or park across the Piedmont Triad? Use RidetheTriad's interactive Transit to Trails Map. Simply click the map below to get started. In case you are not comfortable with maps, use the list of trails below and click the link to get some information on the trail and how to get there.

There are three ways to find a trailhead and trail to explore...

One, click the Bookmark Icon.





Choose a Trail to view by clicking the icon or on the name in the list.

The map will zoom to a view of the trail and transit route. The trails are brown. The transit routes and bus stops are different colors depending on the transit system.



Two, explore the map by zooming in and panning around.

Three, use the address bar and enter your address to see if there are any options near you.

Once at the trail and trailhead you are interested in...

Click on the Bus Stop to see the Bus Stop Name and Transit System.

Click on the Transit Route to see the route name, transit system and a link to the transit system web page. If more than one route serves that trailhead you will see "(1 of 4)" in the upper lefthand corner of the dialogue box. If so, click the ▶ in the upper righthand corner of the dialogue box to see additional route information.



Click on the trail to view information about the trail and links to 1) a Google Street View of the bus stop location, 2) Google directions to the trail and 3) a trail web site for more information about the trail.


Use the Google Street View to check for the conditions from the bus stop to the trailhead. PLEASE use your own judgment when determining how safe the walk or bike ride is from the bus stop to the trailhead.

When using Google maps to get directions to the trail, enter your location in the top address bar (1). Then click the bus icon (2, above the top address third from the left, for directions to the trailhead via public transportation.

Underneath the addresses on the left side, you can click "Leave now" (3) to plan your trip for a different day or time. To the right of "Leave now" is a link to "Options" (4) where you can change the characteristics of your directions.

Underneath that is a link to send the directions to your smartphone. (5)

Underneath that are your directions to the trailhead via public transportation. (6) If you need assistance with the transit directions call Piedmont Transit Resources at 336-883-7278.
