### **Federal Fiscal Year 2020 to 2022 Proposed Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Goal**

Notice is hereby given that the Piedmont Authority for Regional Transportation (PART) is establishing their proposed (FFY) 2020 to (FFY) 2022 Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program goal for the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) assisted contracting opportunities. In conformance with implementing regulation 49 CFR Parts 23 and 26, as amended, the Piedmont Authority for Regional Transportation (PART) is developing the goal based on federal regulations of the United States Department of Transportation (USDOT) for DBE participation in PART's FTA contract activities for goods and services that PART needs for the years mentioned.

The purpose of this notice is to afford certified DBEs, general contractor groups, minorities, and woman's organizations an opportunity to participate and comment on the draft FFY-2020 to FFY-2022 DBE Goal. PART hereby announces its Fiscal Years 2020, 2021 and 2022 goal of .48% for DBE participation on contracts assisted by the Federal Transit Administration (FTA). The PART DBE program proposed goal and methodology may be reviewed for 30 days starting with the first day of publication of this notice during normal business hours from 8:30 a.m.-5:00 p.m., Monday-Friday at the PART administrative office, located at 107 Arrow Rd., Greensboro, NC 27409.
